Guard Production The film marked a departure for director William Castle as this was the first feature film he did not produce, instead co-producing with Len Rupp

as Centennial Films. The film was originally titled *The Inexperienced Killers*. Castle changed the title after he saw a preview of the film, now called *The Agony, Achieved*, where he thought it was much better and was attracted by the ironic title. The film's cost was \$1 million and was financed by Larry Gordon, a big-screen producer who also co-produced the film with Centennial. The budget was so low, "that when [Castle] took the film to the sound stage, his brother, who was a sound engineer, spotted several cockroaches crawling on the floor." Castle cut into the budget to change the location of the film from Calgary, Alberta, Canada to the Yukon Territory in the Northwest Territories of Canada.
